CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

1. The Bush Campground has a maximum of thirty (30) sites which complies with the Yorke Peninsula Council requirements for septic tank waste water treatment.
2. Fees are set at *\$15 per night or \$90 per week* for sites payable in advance for all campground users.
3. Maximum site occupation is six (6) people comprising no more than four (4) adults.
4. One site allows for a towing vehicle plus a caravan or motor home or camper trailer or tent. Car/trailer top mounted boats are permitted.
Please ensure your vehicles are no closer than 3 metres from adjoining campsite sites and vehicles.
5. Site occupancy is for a maximum of six (6) weeks.
6. Dump Point is provided for campground patrons use only except by prior arrangement with PJPA representative. Only black or grey water toilet systems to be emptied, no other waste to be deposited.
7. Fires – total fire bans, as designated by the Statewide fire ban dates, must be complied with. Signs are installed in the bush camp area.
8. No generators to be run between 9.30pm and 8.00am daily and must not be left unattended.
9. All dogs to be on a leash at all times and their droppings to be picked up bagged and binned appropriately.
10. Cutting of trees or bushes that surround the Bush Camp area for the purpose of a campfire shall not be permitted.
11. Excessive noise after 10.00pm will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with the Caretakers' direction may result in you being asked to vacate the campground.
12. Please use the toilets for which they are designed. Please wrap soiled objects and bag them before placing in an appropriate bin.
13. Vehicle drivers must comply with speed limit in the campground of 10 km/h.
14. Port Julia Progress Association Management Committee has set these Regulations in place to comply with Yorke Peninsula Council requirements and also for the enjoyment of other campers.
15. Failure to observe any of these regulations may result in your eviction from the Campground.
